Most days in dubai are sunny throughout the year. Winters are warm and short with a mean high of 23 °C (73 °F) and overnight lows of 14 °C (57 °F). According to Healy Consultants, Dubai is that the top business gateway for the center East and Africa

The fact is, Dubai is one among the safest cities within the world, with very low crime rates meaning travelling round the city is extremely safe. That said, Dubai may be a big world city and customary sense precautions should be observed.
